



Recommendation For Honorary Doctorate Degree of Sacred Letters

An Honorary Doctorate Degree is exactly what it sounds like. A degree to honor someone for their faithfulness. This is given to those who are not seeking to bring recognition to themselves but are worthy and cherished by those around them. A person that would be considered has faithfully served in the faith for many years and has impacted their community with their calling.

There are no minimum credit hours required for an Honorary Doctorate degree; however, you must clearly state and define the terms whereby this individual should be recognized and conferred a degree of honor.

Three (3) letters of recommendation are required in addition to support this request.

These letters should come from men or women of God that have had the opportunity to observe not only the individual's spiritual character but their impact on their community.

Jacksonville Theological Seminary may only issue two Honorary Doctorate Degrees each year and not all recommendations are granted. Therefore, this is not taken lightly or without much prayer and consideration.

The school officials take in to consideration many factors when granting these degrees. For example: How long the individual has been in ministry, what type of an impact does this individual have on his/her community, is the individual unable to "Earn" a Doctorate degree through normal academic means.

Once the recommendation packet arrives with all the information listed above the school officials will review the information and let you know of the individual's acceptance or non-acceptance status.

If the individual is accepted, you will be sent an application for degree along with a student application that should be filled out and sent back to the school.
